Announcement and Call for Papers

The 175th anniversary of P. I. Tchaikovsky's birthday is celebrated in 2015. To mark this special occasion the Museum in cooperation with the State Institute of Art and Moscow P. I. Tchaikovsky Conservatory is holding the above-mentioned International Scientific Conference dedicated to the creative heritage of the composer.

The topics to be discussed in the conference are following:

- The fate of P. I. Tchaikovsky's heritage in the XIX-XXI centuries.
- New facts and documents about the life and work of Tchaikovsky, the history of his compositions.
- Unknown documents of the composer's archive.
- Performers and performing interpretation of P. I. Tchaikovsky's works in the history of the national and international musical and theatrical practice.
- Modern methodology of the Humanities in the study of the texts of P. I. Tchaikovsky's works.
- Musical and critical works of P. I. Tchaikovsky in the mirror of the Russian theatrical culture history of the XIX century.
- Scientific and pedagogical heritage of P. I. Tchaikovsky in the light of the Music Education history and scientific and theoretical works of the XIX-XXI centuries.

The conference will take place in the P.I. Tchaikovsky State Memorial Musical Museum-Reserve in Klin.

The languages of the conference are Russian and English. Papers presented in the conference should last not more than 20 minutes; short communications will be allotted 10 minutes.

If you would like to participate in the conference, please send an abstract including your personal information (name, position held), contact details (mailing address and e-mail address), the subject of your paper and an abstract (up to 3000 characters). The abstract may be sent by mail, fax or email (as .doc or .pdf).

The deadline for the submission of abstract is 15th September, 2015. Applicants will be notified as to whether they have been accepted for participation in the conference by 1st October 2015.

Participants will be able to enjoy the cultural program during the conference: master classes and concerts of the leading musicians and a tour of the P.I. Tchaikovsky State Memorial Musical Museum-Reserve including various exhibitions and a visit to the museum archive.

Conference Organizing Committee reserves the right to select submitted materials for inclusion into the Conference Program and their further publication.

This announcement is a formal invitation to participate in the conference.

All travel and accommodation expenses will be paid for by the participants.
